NSU Health Professions

Nutritional Sciences B.S.

Nutritional Sciences offers a Bachelor of Science degree with two options: Dietetics and Allied Health. The Didactic Program in Dietetics prepares a student to become a Registered Dietitian or Registered Dietitian Nutritionist. The Allied Health option within the Nutritional Sciences program will allow students to utilize this bachelor degree to meet prerequisites for a variety of health professional programs, such as occupational therapy, physical therapy, radiologic therapy, dental hygiene and physician assistant.

Nursing M.S.N. (online)

Speech-Language Pathology B.S.

Speech-Language Pathology M.S.

Speech-Language Pathology is a program that prepares individuals to evaluate the speaking, language, interpretation and related physiological and cognitive capabilities of children and/or adults and develop treatment and rehabilitative services in consultation with clinicians and educators.

Occupational Therapy M.S.

The Master of Science in Occupational Therapy Program is a 24-month program that prepares students for practice, particularly in rural practice settings. Students gain skills and experience through hands on learning opportunities that prepare them for work in pediatric and adult settings.





Physician Assistant M.S.

The mission of the Physician Assistant Studies Program at Northeastern State University is to graduate qualified and compassionate physician assistants to address the shortage of providers in rural northeastern Oklahoma and among American Indian populations. The program will graduate students proficient in clinical reasoning and self-directed learning through a comprehensive curriculum of basic and clinical sciences.

Public Health M.P.H.

NSU provides two opportunities to improve health outcomes through specialized preparation and training of global health leaders, community outreach, and collaboration with community partners through careers in public health. The didactic portion is 100% online, and students complete a 200-hour immersive practicum working directly with community partners. In 14 short months, students can complete a Master of Public Health (MPH) in two specializations: Global Health or Public Health Leadership.

OTHER DEGREE OPTIONS

Reach Higher/Organizational Leadership (Online)

NSU Muskogee has been an active member of the seven institutional partnerships in Oklahoma's Reach Higher Degree Completion Program since it was established in 2007. The program is a statewide initiative designed by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to assist working adults in the completion of their bachelor's degree in an online format. Focusing on adult students, the Reach Higher FlexFinish program is designed to help adults who have earned at least 60 college credit hours complete a degree while balancing family, work and financial obligations. The curriculum was created to meet the needs of today's businesses. Students will build knowledge and skills in areas like organizational behavior, management, ethics, interpersonal skills, communication and finance.
