

TRANSFER STUDENT CHECKLIST

While admissions requirements vary for different types of students, the basics are the same for everyone.

- Complete an application online at apply.nsuok.edu. Pay the \$25 non-refundable application fee.
- ✓ Provide official transcripts from each college you previously attended. In-process transcripts are accepted.
- ✓ If you have 23 or fewer hours of college credit, you must also submit an official high school transcript and your ACT scores.
- Students who graduated from a high school outside of the United States, and have not received an Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree from a U.S. regionally accredited institution, will also need to submit their TOEFL scores.

Reverse Transfer
