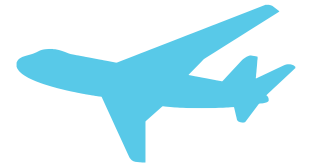

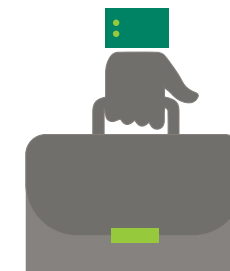

NEED FINANCIAL AID?

Complete the **FREE** Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after **Oct. 1**. State grants will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis.

You can sign up for a FSA I.D. number at fsaid.ed.gov and apply at fafsa.gov.

Don't be fooled by websites that try to make you pay to fill out your FAFSA — *it's free!*

Scholarship Deadlines

MAY 1

TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

This program awards scholarships to students transferring to NSU for the first time.

AUG. 1

TRIBAL HERITAGE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship waives out-of-state tuition for full-time NSU students who are tribal citizens from a federally recognized tribe.

QUAD STATE INCOMING STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

These awards may be available to students from Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri or Texas.

These awards may also be stacked with Oklahoma's Promise funding. All scholarships are limited in number, therefore students are encouraged to apply on or before the deadline. Scholarships are not automatic and are awarded based on availability of funds and application receipt date. Students can only receive one of the tuition waivers.

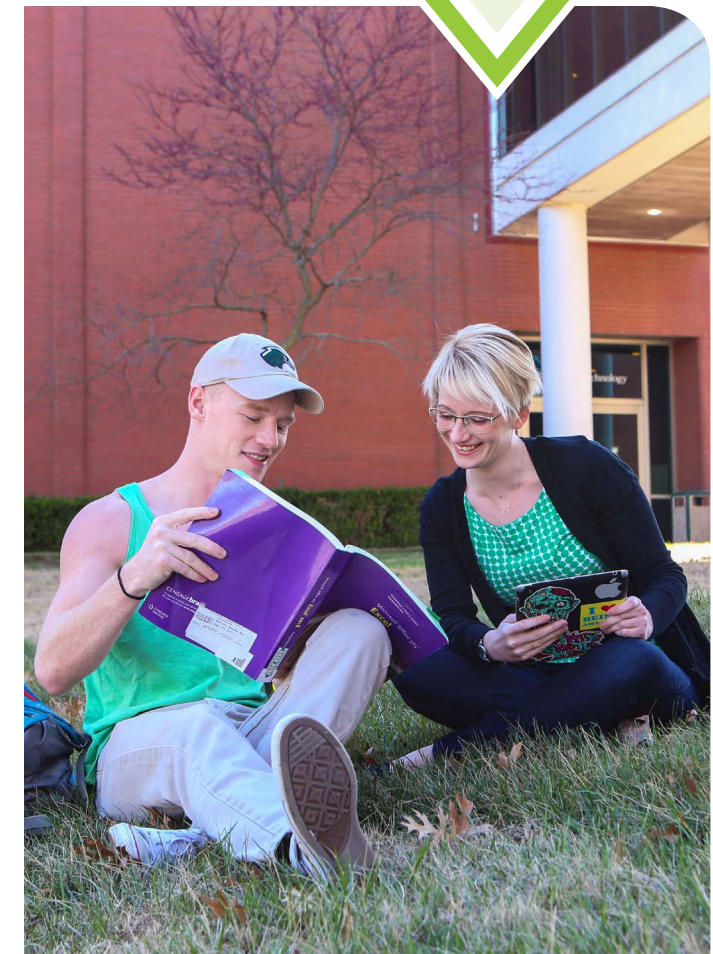

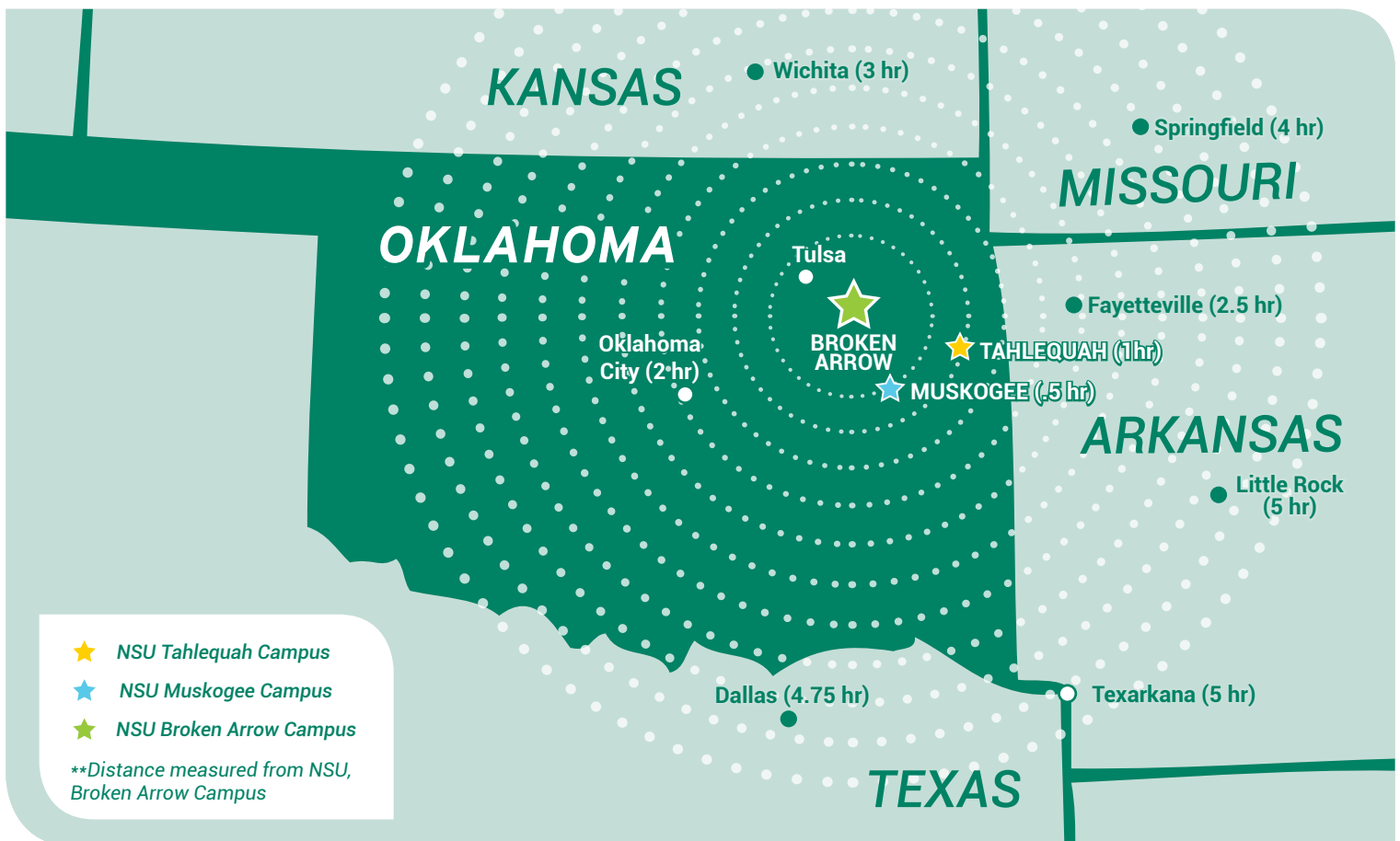
