NSU TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

Students transferring to NSU for the first time may be eligible for transfer scholarships. Students must also be admitted to NSU and apply for scholarships by the deadline in order to be considered.

OUT-OF-STATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Spring Semester Deadline: Jan. 1
Summer/Fall Semester Deadline: Aug. 1

QUAD-STATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Available to incoming freshman and transfer students from Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri or Texas that meet regular admission requirements.

- This scholarship program waives 100% of non-resident tuition when living on campus. Students are still responsible for the in-state tuition costs.
- Legacy students whose parent, grandparent or sibling earned a bachelor's or master's degree from NSU may receive the same benefits without the on-campus living requirement.

TRIBAL HERITAGE SCHOLARSHIP

Available to students from states other than Oklahoma that meet regular admission requirements and are a member of a federally recognized tribe.

- This scholarship program waives 100% of non-resident tuition. Students are still responsible for the in-state tuition costs.

NON-RESIDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Available to students who are not residents of Oklahoma, Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri or Texas that live on campus and meet regular admission requirements.

- This scholarship program waives 50% of non-resident tuition. Students are still responsible for the remaining non-resident portion as well as the in-state tuition costs.
- Incoming freshmen who have a minimum 3.0 unweighted GPA and a 20 composite ACT score may be eligible for the non-resident scholarship.
- Transfer students who have a minimum 2.75 GPA may be eligible for the non-resident scholarship.
- Legacy students whose parent, grandparent or sibling earned a bachelor's or master's degree from NSU may receive the same benefits without the on-campus living requirement.

PURSUING ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

NSU's Broken Arrow campus offers only upper division and graduate courses. The majority of your time on campus will be in classes directly related to your major.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

24 - 30 credit hours | 1.7 GPA (cumulative)
31+ credit hours | 2.0 GPA (cumulative)

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Official transcripts can be mailed or sent electronically. Concurrent high school credits and zero-level course work do not apply toward transfer admission requirements.

- » Official college/university transcripts from all institutions attended
- » Official high school transcript (if fewer than 24 credit hours post high school not including developmental courses)

DOWNTIME



- » Submit your application
- » Pay the \$25 non-refundable application fee
- » Check your application Self-Service Center for required documents by going to apply.nsuok.edu and click Finish Application or Check Status.

□ SUBMIT YOUR OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Your application is not complete until these are received. Once all required documents are submitted, you will receive an admission decision within 7-8 business days, via mail.



□ BOOK YOUR ENROLLMENT APPOINTMENT


