Optional Practical Training allows students in F-1 status to work part-time or full-time in his/her field of study for up to 12 months after completion of each degree level (e.g. Bachelor, Master, Doctorate). This work can be unpaid, part-time or full-time. Students on OPT musk work a minimum of 20 hours per week.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Let's see if you meet one of the following minimum requirements!

- 2.7 GPA (cumulative, underweight) & minimum TOEFL score of 61 or IELTS score of 5.5 or PTE Academic 44 or iTEP Academic 3.5.
- Minimum 2.7 GPA and transcript showing high school diploma was completed within the United States or from an NSU-approved, native English-speaking country.

GRADUATE ADMISSION

You must have earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Wanting to enroll at NSU? Let's see if you're qualified!

- Minimum TOEFL score of 79 or IELTS score of 6.5 or PTE Academic 53 or iTEP Academic 4.0. AND
- 2.5 GPA based on a 4.0 scale on all undergraduate coursework attempted.
- 2.7 GPA based on a 4.0 scale in the last 60 semester hours of undergraduate coursework attempted.



THE RIVERHAWK SHOPEE


