1. Assembly, Line-up, and Processional for Graduates

Graduates enter the facility at the south entrance. Plan to assemble in the practice gym at 6:00 p.m. near the signs indicating your degree. Arrive early and plan on possible parking delays. Staff will assist graduates in locating the staging area and lining up for the processional; it will take the full hour to get graduates ready to proceed at 7:00 p.m. As the ceremony starts, graduates proceed in two lines to the arena, remain in the two lines as they enter the arena, and proceed down the middle aisle where ushers will assist with seating. Please remain standing through the national anthem. During the ceremony, listen carefully to the ceremony officials for graduate instructions and follow ushers' directions. 2. Graduates / Guests with Disabilities

- **Guests** with disabilities will enter the North Lobby. Mabee Center ushers will provide assistance and direct guests to a reserved seating area.

3. Recessional

There will be no recessional. Please be careful when leaving the Mabee Center and during your travels.

a. Caps and Gowns

• Caps and gowns are available at the RiverHawk Shoppe along with honor cords.

- Keep the <u>tassel on the right side</u> and do not change the position of the tassel until directed to do so by the President after all have crossed the stage.
- Please wear appropriate footwear. You should anticipate walking distances, standing for a period of time, and climbing stairs.

There is NOT a secure place to leave personal belongings, and you may be relocated to a different seat during the ceremony. Do not carry cell phones, cameras, purses, etc. since you will need both hands free.

b. Graduation Announcements

Graduation announcements may be ordered through CB Graduation Announcements/Balfour (cbgrad.com).

c. Name Card/Free Color Proof Card

Name cards will be distributed at the Mabee Center when you arrive for line up. You must present the card to the announcer to have your name read. The photographer uses the information on the back for identification purposes.

d. **Diplomas**

After your final grades for the semester are recorded, your eligibility for graduation will be checked. If you meet all requirements and your account with the university is clear, your diploma will be mailed to the address you listed on your application for graduation. If there is a concern with your graduation eligibility, you will be notified via your <u>NSU email</u> following final degree verification. Please make sure your contact information is correct and continue to monitor your **NSU email account**.

SPECIAL REMINDER: Course substitutions, grade changes for incompletes, and transcripts of work completed at other schools **MUST BE IN THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR BY MAY 29, 2020,** for your name to remain on the roster of graduating students for Spring 2020. The deadline for graduating students for Summer 2020 is **August 28, 2020**.

A professional photographer will be taking pictures of graduates prior to entering the stage and as the President congratulates you. There will be no access to the arena floor or stage area for anyone other than graduates and university personnel.
