SMART CHOICE TRANSFER STUDENT CHECKLIST



While admissions requirements vary for different types of students, the basics are the same for everyone.

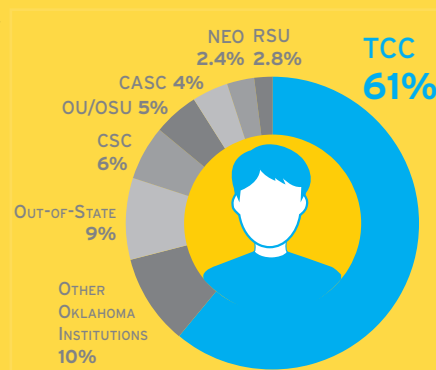
- ✓ Complete an **online application** and pay the \$25 non-refundable application fee.
- ✓ Provide official transcripts from each college you previously attended. In-progress transcripts are accepted.
- ✓ If you have 23 or fewer hours of college credit, you must also submit an official high school transcript and your ACT scores.
- ✓ Students who graduated from a high school outside of the United States, and have not received an Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree from a U.S. regionally accredited institution, will also need to submit their TOEFL scores.

TRANSFER ADMISSION STANDARDS

An undergraduate transfer student has more than six attempted credit hours, excluding remedial (zero-level) or pre-college work and excluding credit hours through concurrent coursework in high school. Students must meet the following requirements:

0- 29 hours **1.7 GPA**
Plus satisfy all freshmen admission requirements

30+ hours **2.0 GPA**

Transfer students who do not meet the above requirements will be reviewed holistically and may be admitted on probation.

Transfer Student Scholarships—Deadline May 1

Quad State Scholarship:

Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri and Texas residents may be eligible for special tuition waivers using a sliding scale and based on a student's GPA.

Foundation Scholarships:

(Deadline March 1) These scholarships are privately funded awards from NSU's Foundation. The money from these awards can apply toward any charges on a student's account.

REVERSE TRANSFER

Only have a few credits remaining for your associate degree? You may be eligible to transfer now! NSU and TCC have collaborated to develop a means for maximizing your prior work.

This agreement allows students to transfer the credits they obtain from NSU to TCC in order to complete the requirements for an associate degree. This process is referred to as a Reverse Transfer.

STEPS TO TRANSFER FROM TCC TO A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY:

- ✓ **Meet with a TCC Academic Advisor** to ensure you have accurate course information.
- ✓ **Determine what your specific major** will be at the transfer institution.
- ✓ **Meet with a transfer representative from that institution** or follow the links for transfer guides found at *TCC's university transfer information page*.
- ✓ Elective courses may not count toward requirements for a bachelor's degree, but will transfer as an elective. **Always check to make sure your course will count toward a degree** at a four-year institution.
